



ORHS Staggered Reopening Plan

We would first like to thank our families for their patience as we navigate these unprecedented times. Our administrative team has been working with district stakeholders to continuously review local data and recommendations to make the best decisions possible for our students and staff. In order to address the challenges associated with social distancing we have adopted a plan that includes a staggered start and return to school.

During the first three days of school, we will be operating at reduced capacity in order to provide the time necessary to distribute school laptops. **Students will only attend one of the first three days of school.** Students participating in ConnectOR will not come to school these days and will receive their laptops on Monday, August 10th. Wednesday July 29th is an Early Release Day. Thursday, July 30th and Friday, July 31st will be full length school days. Please refer to the alphabet breakdown below to know which of the three days to send your child to the high school.

Starting on Monday, August 3rd we will be operating at a 50% reduced capacity until the conditions improve enough for us to be back at full capacity. Students will be split into two teams. The **Cardinal** Team will be made up of students with last names **A-L**. The **Gray** team will be made up of students with last name **M-Z**. All students will be attending school two days a week for face-to-face instruction and participating in classwork three days a week through distance learning. All students will access their course work through their teacher's Canvas page.

- Students will be participating in schoolwork five days a week. (Two days in face-to-face, three days working remotely).
- Wednesdays will be a distance learning day for all students.
- **Attendance will be taken daily in both the face-to-face settings and distance learning settings.**
- Students will follow their full regular schedule on their face-to-face days.
- We cannot guarantee that all classes will be perfectly balanced, but our goal is to have 15 students or less in most classrooms.
- This plan is for students participating in Option #1. It does not apply to ConnectOR students.
- Consideration will be given to blended families who have students with different last names living in the same home, please contact Amy Campbell akcampbell@ortn.edu in the Counseling Department to have students moved onto the same team.
- This staggered approach increases student and staff safety due to smaller numbers to socially distance in classrooms, communal spaces, hallways, lunch, chorus, band, and PE.
- Students participating in all special Dual Enrollment classes such as DE Calculus 3, DE Automotive, DE Statistics, DE Spanish 4 and others will also be following this schedule.
- Our CDC students will be participating in face-to-face settings Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.
- Students will have the opportunity to pick up meals from the school on their distance learning days. Meals will be offered free, at a reduced rate, or full pay depending on the student's status.
