

Administrative Procedure 6.201 (B)

Enrollment of Students 18 Years

and Older

Enrollment of Students 18 Years and Older

A person eighteen (18) years of age or older who applies for admission to Oak Ridge Schools must have their application approved by the Superintendent of Schools/designee if they have met any of the following conditions:

1. Failed to enroll within thirty (30) calendar days after school officially starts,
2. Dropped out of school and requested to return,
3. Completed four years of high school and failed to graduate with their cohort,
4. Charged with a felony or a crime involving a weapon,
5. Lacked the credits necessary to graduate with their assigned cohort,
6. Received a diploma or other certificate of graduation, or
7. Enrolled and making satisfactory progress in a course leading to a GED.

If the request to enroll in Oak Ridge Schools is denied, the Office of Pupil Services will provide the student a contact list of organizations that provide support in earning a GED/diploma.
