## **Enrollment of Students 18 Years and Older**

A person eighteen (18) years of age or older who applies for admission to Oak Ridge Schools must have their application approved by the Superintendent of Schools/designee if they have met any of the following conditions:

- 1. Failed to enroll within thirty (30) calendar days after school officially starts,
- 2. Dropped out of school and requested to return,
- 3. Completed four years of high school and failed to graduate with their cohort,
- 4. Charged with a felony or a crime involving a weapon,
- 5. Lacked the credits necessary to graduate with their assigned cohort,
- 6. Received a diploma or other certificate of graduation, or
- 7. Enrolled and making satisfactory progress in a course leading to a GED.

If the request to enroll in Oak Ridge Schools is denied, the Office of Pupil Services will provide the student a contact list of organizations that provide support in earning a GED/diploma.
