Administrative Procedure 6.308
Bus Emergency Response Protocol

In the event of a BUS EMERGENCY, the following steps will be taken:

- **#1** 1. The bus driver will contact dispatch.
 - 2. First Student Supervisor and bus driver will determine if bus route can be conducted safely or if they should immediately stop the bus.
 - 3. If determined for bus to stop, driver is required to remain on bus to provide student supervision.
 - 4. If appropriate, the bus driver will call 9-1-1 to request emergency support.
 - 5. First Student Supervisor will contact the appropriate school(s) to share reported concern.
 - 6. School representative will report to the scene to support bus driver, as appropriate.
 - 7. If Oak Ridge Police Department has responded, they will manage the scene until all students/staff are safe.
 - 8. Students will exit the bus ONLY if their immediate safety is in jeopardy by staying on the bus.
 - 9. If students are required to exit bus, they are to be relocated a safe distance from bus and vehicle traffic.
 - 10. School Administration and/or First Student will contact parents, as appropriate.
 - 11. School Administration will be responsible for releasing students to confirmed parent/guardian.

#2 In the event of a BUS EMERGENCY involving violence, the following steps will be taken:

- 1. The bus driver will continue the scheduled bus route, unless the driver determines students are in immediate danger.
 - The steps listed above will be followed if driver determines students are in immediate danger.
- 2. School Administration will notify the Oak Ridge Police Department (ORPD) and report threat.
- 3. School Administration and ORPD will address reported concern once bus arrives at school.
- 4. The student(s) being reported as potential threat will be separated and isolated immediately. The School Resource Officer (SRO) or ORPD will lead with separating/isolating student(s) if threat involves a weapon.
- 5. School Administration will investigate to determine appropriate action.
- 6. If reported threat is received during PM bus route, administration will contact parents/guardians while restricting their student from riding bus and attending school the next day until an investigation has been conducted to determine appropriate action.
