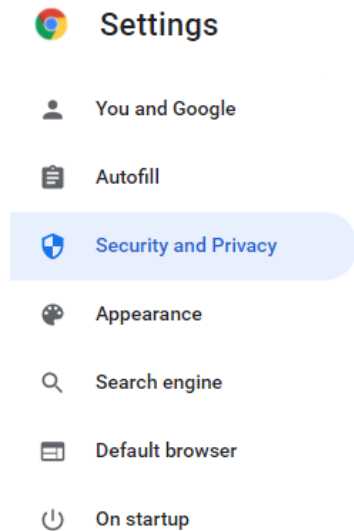


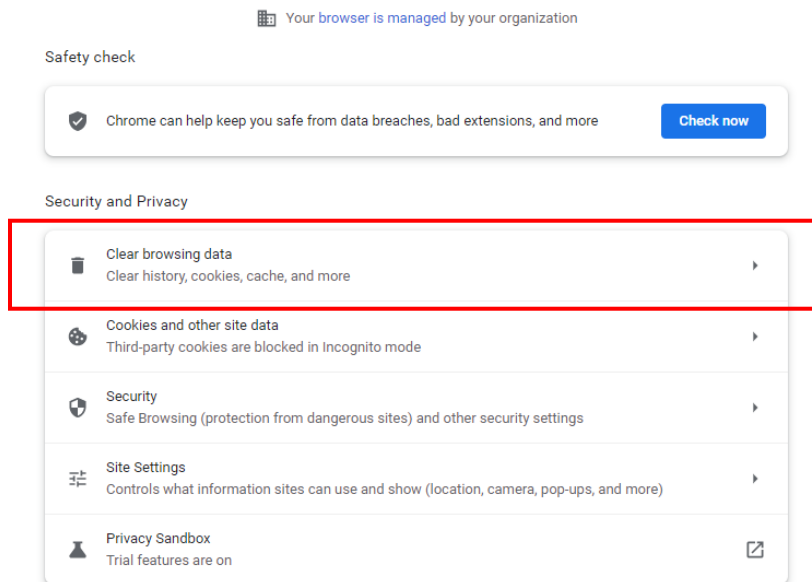
Clearing Browser Cache

For Chrome

1. Click on the three vertical dots in the top right corner of your Chrome browser.
2. Click **Settings** in the menu.
3. In the left-hand menu, select **Security and Privacy**.



4. On the next page, select **Clear Browsing Data**.



5. In the pop up window, check the box next to **Cached images and files**. Make sure that your date range is at least 7 days. **Click Clear Data**.
