- b. Provide grade level specific information regarding the academic content focus for each grading period and ideas for how parents can support their student's mastery of these concepts outside the classroom.
- c. Provide parents with frequent reports to share information about your student's individual academic and behavioral progress. Progress reports will be communicated through standards-based report cards(quarterly), telephone calls and/or electronic communication(as needed), and parent-teacher conferences(at least one per semester).
- d. Staff will be available for consultation by appointment.

Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their student's class and observe classroom activities as follows:

- a. Serve as a representative on school improvement and advisory committees
- b. Chaperone field trips

- c. Help with special classroom projects and school events
- d. Invite parents to serve on advisory boards for the school and district as an opportunity for shared decision making
