There are many ways students can share their talents. Acts may include musical numbers (vocal & instrumental), dances, skits, poetry readings, art presentations, and more. All acts must be school appropriate.

Your parent can sign the printed form and then scan or take a photo to submit, or he/she can sign electronically in the PDF.
3. After you have completed steps 1 & 2, you will be invited to join the talent show Canvas course, where you will submit your work. You can use a variety of tools and apps to record your talent. **All acts must be submitted by Friday, May 8, 2020.**

Our goal is to post the talent show video prior to the rollup of laptops begins so that students can easily access the show through a link posted in Canvas.

Please note that submission of an act does not guarantee inclusion in the talent show video. Your video may be edited/shortened. Acts are limited to TWO MINUTES. Please record your video in LANDSCAPE (HORIZONTAL) mode. Any acts depicting dangerous behavior or violating social distancing guidelines will be disqualified.
